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1. Introduction

The Infrastructure Funding Statement (IFS) is an annual report published by Tunbridge Wells Borough Council (TWBC) that provides a summary of all financial and non-financial developer contributions relating to Section 106 (S106) legal agreements within the borough of Tunbridge Wells within a given financial year. This document details the financial contributions secured in the financial year 2021/22.

2. Section 106 Planning Obligations

Planning obligations known as S106 agreements are legal agreements that can be attached to a planning permission to mitigate the impact of the development. Obligations can only be sought when they are directly related, of reasonable related scale and type to the development and are necessary to make the development acceptable in planning terms. S106 obligations can be both financial and non-financial and can be provided on-site, such as through the provision of affordable housing, or off-site as financial payments, such as through a financial contribution to provide for a specific piece of infrastructure.

Throughout this document the following definitions will be used:

- **Agreed** This refers to contributions, monetary and non-monetary that have been agreed within a signed and completed S106 legal document.
- **Received** This refers to monetary contributions received that have been transferred to TWBC.
- Allocated This refers to monetary contributions that have been both received and allocated to a specific project. This includes both capital project allocation and noncapital allocation as not all financial contributions are spent through capital projects. Most contributions have specific uses detailed in their S106s so money often comes in and is already ear-marked for specific work. If this is for a specific piece of work this is detailed as "allocated".

- **Spent/Transferred** This refers to contributions, monetary or non-monetary that have been spent or delivered to a third party.
- **TWBC-** Tunbridge Wells Borough Council
- KCC- Kent County Council
- NHS- National Health Service
- This financial year Unless stated otherwise this refers to the 2021/22 financial year that spans from 01/04/2021 31/03/2022

3. S106 Contributions agreed during 21/22

Detailed in this section are the financial and non-financial obligations agreed during the 2021/22 financial year. All figures in this section are without indexation which is added at the time of payment. Section 106s connected to applications that have been appealed and dismissed or superceded are not included. 6. S106 Projects

Below are some examples of projects in the community that TWBC section 106 money has been spent on in 2021/22. Many other contributions also helped to fund KCC projects that are not detailed here (see money transferred to KCC in the previous section).

Crescent Road Affordable Housing



Together with a Homes England Grant, £310,000.00 of Section 106 contribution funding was used to provide six long term homes that can be used for former rough sleepers in the borough. This project involved the renovation of three empty properties on Cresent Road in Tunbridge Wells. The properties were in fairly poor condition and this money was needed to bring them up to a good standard. The work included improvement to the EPC rating of the properties and upgrades to internal features.

£6,000.00 of Section 106 money from the Furnace Lane site in Horsmonden went towards relocating reptiles from the site before development took place to a suitable alternative habitat. In the summer of 2021, 123 Slow Worms and 28 common lizards were translocated from the Furnace Lane development site in Horsmonden to Robingate Wood, where Kent High Weald Partnership has an ongoing reptile habitat preservation and creation project. Before the transfer, the site was prepared by Kent High Weal Partnership and local volunteers. This work included creating hibernaculums (hibernation spaces), scrapes (shallow, seasonal water bodies) and general management of the healthland, the habitat that naturally provides essential habitat features for reptiles. Once the reptiles were onsite, two volunteer task days were spent removing birch trees from the heathland to prevent the healthland from succession into woodland. The first year of surveys were conducted in the spring of 2022, with sightings of both species. The remaining funding will go towards ongoing surveys and habitat management that will carry on until 2024/25. The surveying programme will be expanded from 3 surveys to four to get a better picture of the reptile populations.

Goudhurst football pitch maintenance and repair

£3,498.06 of S106 money went towards a payment of £6,000.00 to Goudhurst Parish Council for the repair and maintenance of the football pitch in Goudhurst.
